Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are organising a "Taster" day in St. Joseph's High School for Primary 6 pupils on **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March**. The proposed programme is outlined below:

- The Primary 6 pupils will come into school on the same buses used by our own pupils (KS3 pupils will avail of a study day on this date.) School starts at 8.30 am and I would suggest that you find out from a relative or friend what time your child needs to be at the designated bus stop.
- Pupils should wear their Primary school uniform.
- Pupils should bring indoor P.E. gear as there will be sporting activities.
- The Primary 6 pupils will be split into 10 groups for the day. They will be given the opportunity to work in and have experience of, the following subjects:
  - (a) P.E.
  - (b) Science
  - (c) Technology and Design
  - (d) Home Economics
  - (e) Music
- Each session will last approximately one hour.
- Break will be at 9.45-10.00 am and lunch at 12.00-12.40 pm and both will be provided by us. **It is imperative that you inform us of any medical or special dietary requirements that your child has, including allergies. Children in receipt of FSM will receive their lunch as usual.**
- Pupils will go home at 2.35 pm on our school buses.
- **If any of your pupils have a statement of Special Educational Needs and require adult assistance, please inform the school at your earliest convenience so that support can be offered.**
